Eligibility for audition based courses will be determined before schedules are built. Pre-register for the NON-audition classes.

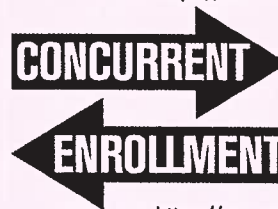

MARK DATE IN YOUR CALENDAR

- Pink Course Registration Form completed *with signatures* by end of day February 19th
- Enter classes into PowerSchool on either Monday, **February 22nd** @ home, or in person periods 1-8 on **February 23rd** (Cohort A) or **24th** (Cohort B) in the computer lab during your off period.
- Return form to your English teacher Cohort A- **February 25th** / Cohort B- **February 26th**
- Computer will build all Sophomore schedules over the summer

Freshmen! Now that you have reviewed graduation requirements and HEAR (college) requirements and have created your 4-year plan, here are a few other details that you may want to know about. If you qualify for any of these options, you may want to adjust your 4-year plan and plan your future class schedules accordingly.

P.E. Waiver Option ○○○○○○○○○○○○○○○○○

HOW DOES IT HAPPEN?

After completion of a qualifying waiver requirement your counselor will submit the PE waiver request.

The Cherry Creek School District allows students to receive a **one-time P.E. waiver** during their entire high school career.

- **Athletic Waiver:** participation in a CHSSA-approved sport for one season at a qualifying level.
- **Marching Band:** participation in Marching Band (includes Color Guard) for TWO semesters.

Things to know

- ◆ The athletics office provides counselors with a roster of students who participated in a qualifying sport at the end of each season. Once approved, the waiver will be indicated on your transcript. No student action required.
- ◆ Participation in Non-CHSSA outside sports **DOES NOT QUALIFY** for a district athletic waiver.
- ◆ Marching band requires that the student initiates the waiver process. Pick up a waiver form from the Counseling Office.
- ◆ A waiver does **NOT** give you .5 PE credit! It simply waives you from one semester of the PE graduation requirements. You will be able to take other classes or electives to reach your 22 required credits.
- ◆ If you have any physical limitations that might impact your ability to fulfill your P.E. requirements, please discuss this with your counselor.

Additional Waiver Options ○○○○○○○○○○○

HOW DO THESE HAPPEN?

Your counselor will submit this paperwork for you. **NO student action is needed.**

1) Practical/Fine Arts (PFA) Waiver options

→ Completion of three years in one of the following programs will waive .5 Practical/Fine Arts (PFA) credit:

- AVID ◆ Student Senate ◆ Debate

2) P.E./Practical Fine Arts (PFA) options

- .5 PE OR .5 PFA Waiver: Available to students who have completed 19 credits by the end of junior year and are on track to earn 25 credits at the end of senior year.
- .5 P.E. AND .5 PFA: Available to students who have completed 20.5 credits by the end of junior year and are on track to earn 26 credits at the end of senior year.

◆ ◆ ◆ Please note ◆ ◆ ◆

Per district policy, only .5 P.E. of any type can be waived during high school. Students cannot earn a waiver for athletics or band and also try to waive P.E. for either of the above options.

3) Health option

→ Students who complete one semester of Interpersonal Relationships .5 PFA credit (formerly Contemporary Relationships) AND Culinary Arts 1 .5 PFA credit (formerly Foods/Nutrition).

○○○○○○○○○○ Reassignment of Credit Options ○○○○○○○○○○

Completion of specific courses at CCHS can be reassigned for credit in other areas.

- **AP Art History:** Counts as 1.0 PFA credit, but students completing the full year of the course may choose to have .5 credit reassigned to Social Studies credit.
- **AP Computer Science:** Counts as 1.0 Math credit, but students who complete the full year may choose to have 1.0 credit reassigned to PFA credit.

ELECTIVE CHOICES (1st Choice)
