OPTIONS FOR SENIOR YEAR

Registering for 2021-2022 Courses

Step 1: Completing Course Pre-Registration Sheet

1. Review unofficial transcript and consider graduation requirements & college admissions requirements. **Look at Cherry Creek Innovation Campus (CCIC) offerings at cherrycreekschools.org/CCIC.**
2. Consult with teachers, parents and course registration guide about course choices.
3. Fill out your course registration form and secure all required signatures:

Current teachers, parents, student

REMEMBER, these courses are the courses you will self-schedule for in the spring.

- You cannot make changes to these requests before self-scheduling.
- All students must schedule four core classes per semester and sign up for a minimum of five credits.
- Students cannot register for more than seven credits during pre-registration.

Step 2: Entering your course requests into PowerSchool

You will enter your course requests in PowerSchool from home on **Monday, February 8th**, OR in the computer lab periods 1-8 on **Tuesday, February 9th (for Cohort A)** or **Wednesday February 10th (for Cohort B)**. In person is a good option if you have any questions or problems entering your course selections at home. To enter courses in PowerSchool, you must have your completed Pre-Registration forms with all required signatures. Return your completed Pre-Registration form to your English teacher on **Thursday, February 11th (for Cohort A)** or **Friday, February 12th (for Cohort B)**.

Sample Senior Year Schedule

1 full year English class (Senior Seminar, AP Lit or 2 semester English classes)

2 semesters or 1 full year of social studies

(Have you taken American Government or AP US Government?)

(Do you need to take/retake US History 11-12 one or both semesters?)

2 semesters or 1 full year of math

2 semesters or 1 full year of science

Do you need to continue world language?

Fine Arts? (Do you need a full year of TRUE fine arts - such as drawing, orchestra, acting, etc. for college admission?)

P.E.? (Do you qualify for a P.E. waiver? If so, complete and turn in waiver. Form available in Counseling)

Health? (Contemporary Relationships and Foods and Nutrition now have new names. They are now Interpersonal Relationships and Culinary Arts 1. They still count for Practical/Fine Arts credits and, when both are taken, can count as a Health waiver.)



Audition-Based Courses

Eligibility for audition-based courses will be determined before self-scheduling appointments. Pre-register for NON-audition classes.

Concurrent Enrollment Opportunities

Opportunity to earn college credit for assigned high school courses (available in English, math, business, Career/Tech/CTE).

Want to be a Peer Ambassador?

Apply to be a Peer Ambassador and work in the Counseling office! Applications need to be submitted by Friday, February 19th.

Summer Math: Current math teachers will give summer assignments at the end of the school year.

**Online classes DURING the school year through Elevation:

1. You will **NOT** pre-register for online classes you intend to take DURING the school year.
2. The District will be sending updated information soon. Check with your counselor for more details.

**Summer school courses are available through the District summer school (in-person) or Elevation (online)

1. Some courses are available to get ahead through Elevation
2. Check to see if you can retake any core course you earned a D or an F in during summer school.

****Registration for summer school begins after Spring Break. Tuition required to enroll.**
